CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:06 AM

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve the March 24, 2022 minutes made by **Winnebago County**: Seconded by **Four Rivers Sanitation Authority**. Motion passes by a 4:0:4 vote.

PRESENTATIONS & PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

OLD BUSINESS

a) Map outage troubleshooting

Mr. Gregg reported that another call with Esri is scheduled to continue to address the, now less frequent, map outages. Mr. Gregg believes that much of the issue stems from IIS settings on the server and the configuration of the Web Adaptors.

b) Public and Subscription Beta Sites Live

Mr. Gregg informs the group that a link to the beta site has been placed on the existing site giving users a chance to preview the new site and provide feedback.

c) Open Positions

In addition to the Web Developer position posted, Mr. Gregg reports that WinGIS will have a Web Developer intern this summer from NIU. Additionally, another position that is GIS specific has been posted as well. Chris Dornbush requested that his open position be added to the WinGIS website. Mr. Gregg agrees to and confirms that he will place the WinGIS position on the site as well.

NEW BUSINESS

a) WAN Updates

Mr. Gregg informs the group that, for the WAN update, he is considering – and asking for the group’s feedback – to install another Portal and using that for the WAN maps. This second Portal would be only on the WinGIS network, thus allowing users to gain all access to all of the functionality that Portal provides without having to log in. The committee is tentatively in agreement with some testing perhaps this spring/summer with some internal employees using a Property Search built in Portal as a first step.

b) Address Points Update

Sarah Stromberg reports that she edited, for 911 purposes, the combined address point layer to only display one address point where multiple appear (apartment buildings or businesses with suite numbers). She continued to report that she ran an additional analysis on the layer that indicates how close the addresses are to the actual points.

OTHER MATTERS

Chris Dornbush reports that the WinCo Sheriff's Department is once again assuming control of the EOC. A former Rockford Firefighter will be at the helm.
