### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **a) Public Site Updates**

Mr. Gregg reported that one of the previously mentioned site updates that was scheduled to take place had been made, but rolled back. Adjusting the markup color resulted in the loss of some functionality so until that issue can be worked out, that markup color will remain the same.

#### **b) Datum Presentation**

Mr. Gregg commits to sending to the Technical Committee the presentation given by Ben Christiansen on the announced Datum updates announced.

#### **c) Token Security Update**

Mr. Gregg reports that the recent token issues in the last several weeks were a result of him using the incorrect duration for the tokens. New tokens utilized by both WinGIS and City of Rockford have been set with the proper duration.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **a) WAN/Portal updates – Potential and Actual**

After speaking with WinGIS' technical representative at Esri a decision was made – and now proposed to the Technical Committee – to make Portal only available to users on the network. This would essentially become the new WAN. Any Portal maps utilized by internal users in the field, could then be created on WinGIS' ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account. Internal users would not require logins credentials, as they do not now. Some users, however, who do have Portal login credentials may keep them as some maps or apps may only be available to certain groups who log in. The Committee has no objections. The next

phase would be to then utilize AGOL to for WinGIS, even perhaps even WinGIS user agencies, public maps.

Lastly, Sarah Stromberg has reached out to Cloudpoint Geospatial to perform a 1-2 onsite Pro demonstration/tutorial in November for all WinGIS agency users. The training will be held in the training room at the Rockford Park District main office.
